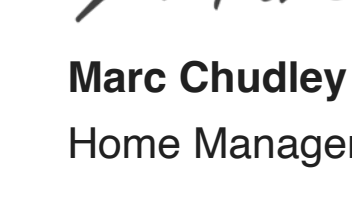
Message From Our Manager

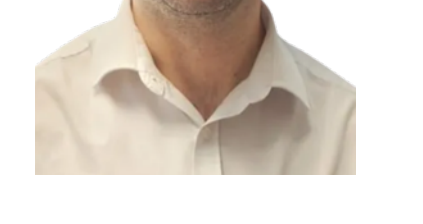

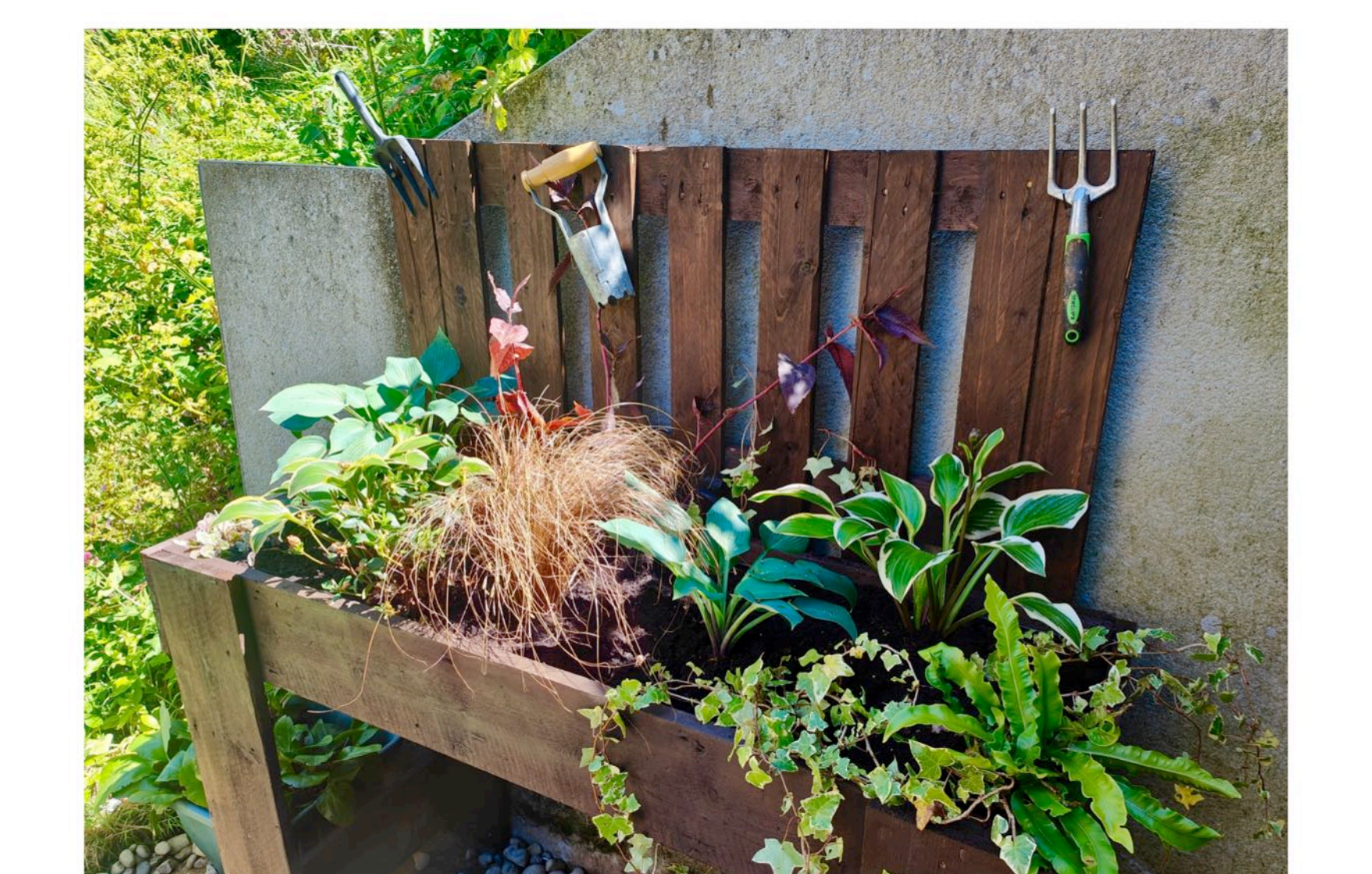
More than just a pastime, flower arranging has given residents a chance to express creativity, revisit cherished memories, and bring a little extra joy into daily life.

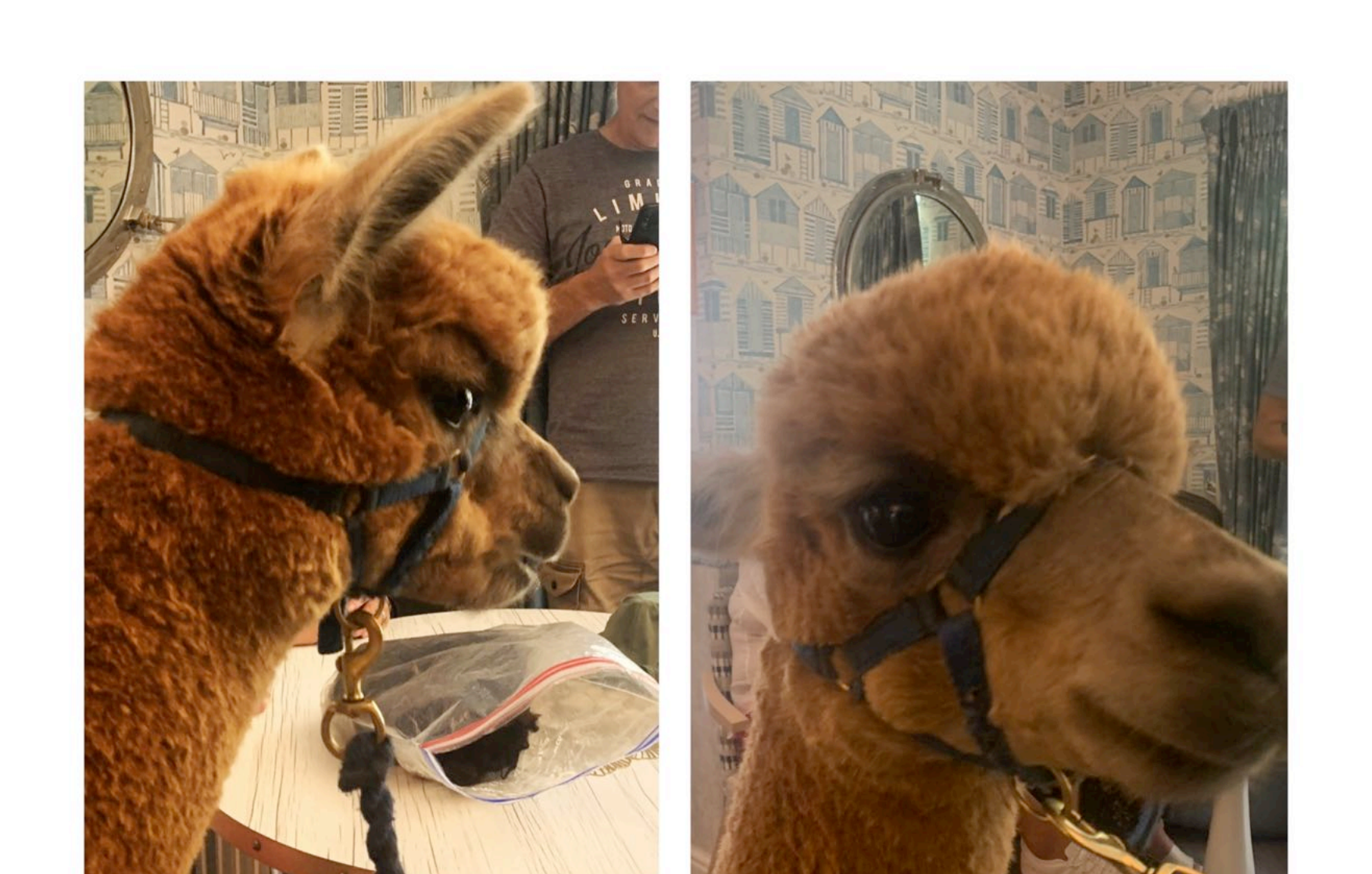

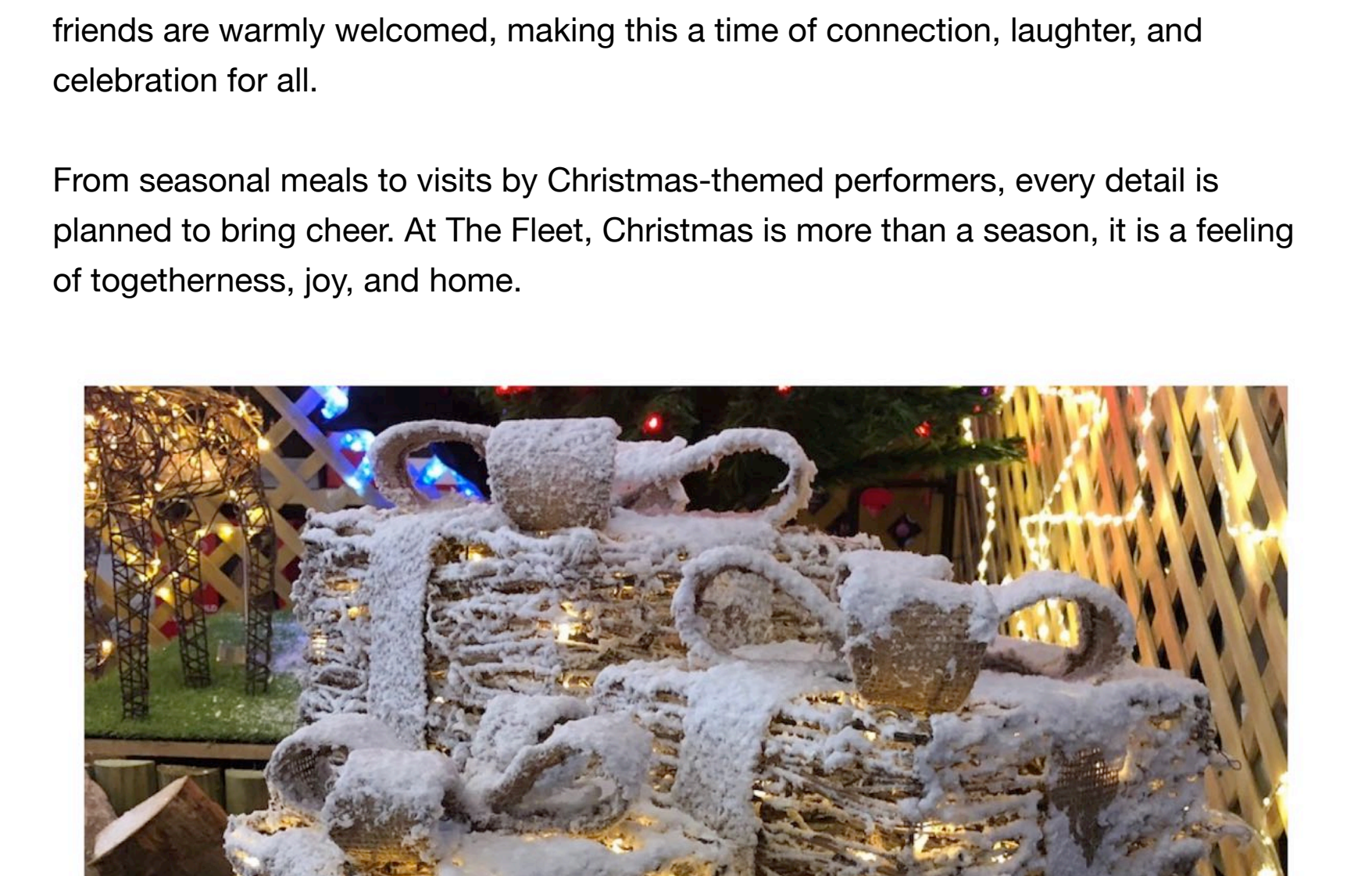
Christmas Joy

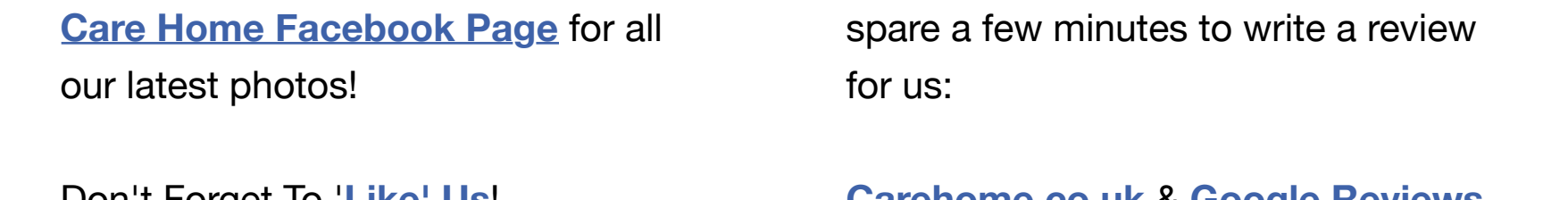
